Figure 1. Properties with Foreclosure Filings by Quarter, Chicago Six County Region

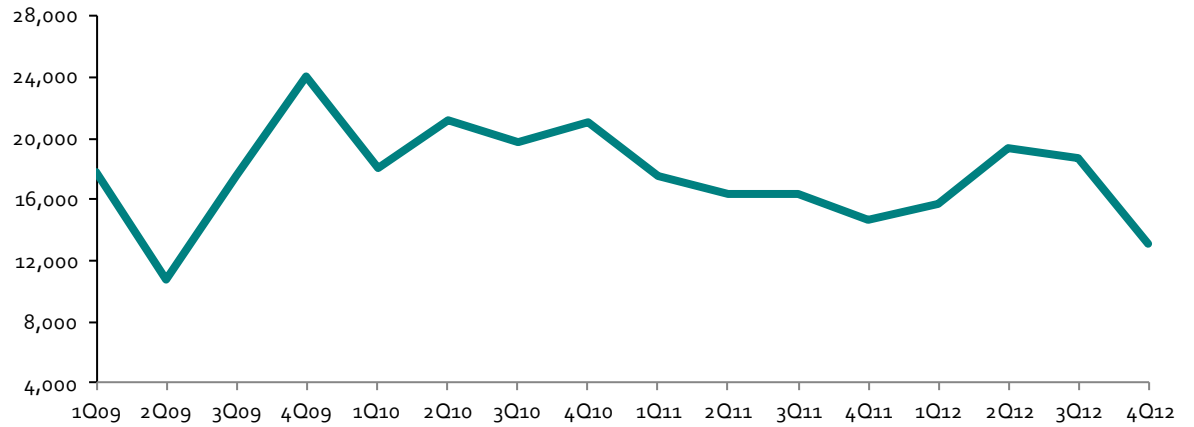

Figure 1. Completed Foreclosure Auctions by Quarter, Chicago Six County Region

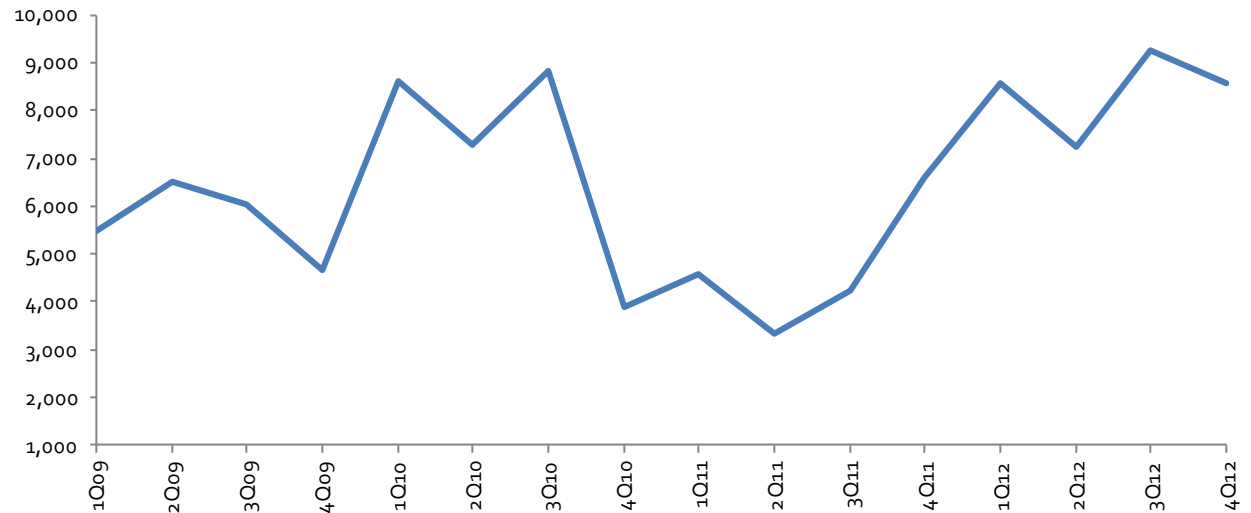
