Figure 1. Properties with Foreclosure Filings by Quarter, Chicago Six-County Region

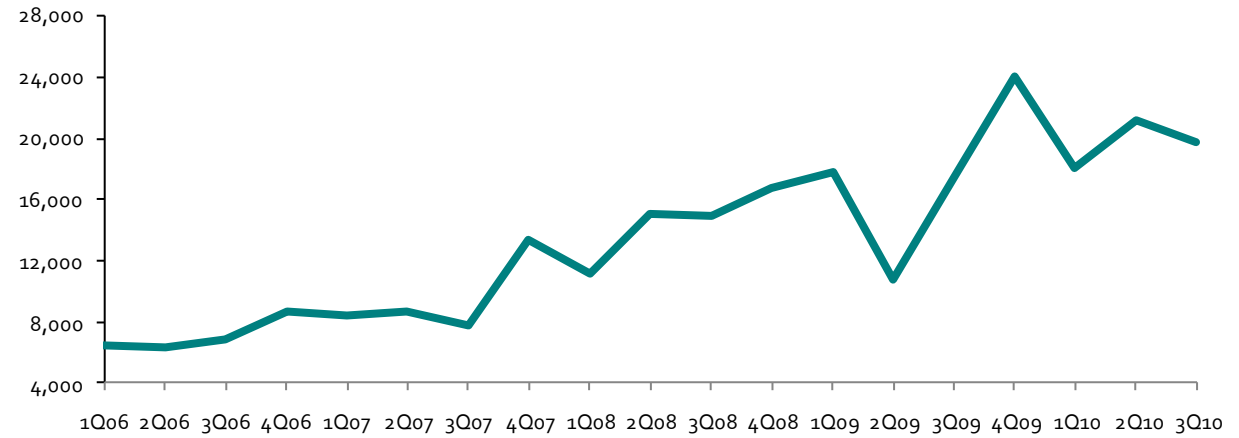

Figure 1. Completed Foreclosure Auctions by Quarter, Chicago Five-County Region (No Lake County)

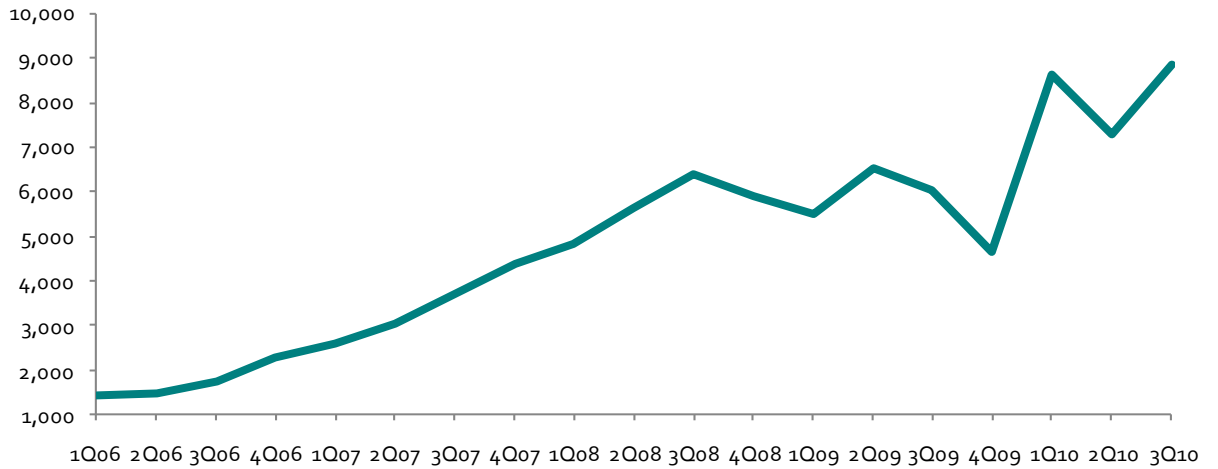
